Subject: Putting up a new memorial page on www.toomuch-bs.com

Hello Everyone;

(as usual please expand your screen)

I invite you to forward this email to all of your friends and family and your email lists. We welcome all submissions of service members for posting.

For the past several months ever since I put www.toomuch-bs.com online to fight on behalf of senior citizens and disabled veterans after it was announced there would not be a COLA increase for 2010 and 2011 and possibly longer, I have been receiving hundreds of requests asking that I put a memorial page on the site.

Ever since Joe Bonsall (lead singer and composer of the OAK RIDGE BOYS) graciously granted his permission to put his tribute to his mom and dad "**GI JOE AND LILLIE**" on the site (it is on the articles page www.toomuch-bs.com/here-s-Johnny.html) I have been considering the time and effort that will be involved and I assure you it will be extremely time consuming. However, after weighing all the pros and cons I feel it will provide a service and another place of tribute and memorial to those who served as well as those who gave it all, as is indicated in the song by Billy Ray Cyrus "**SOME GAVE IT ALL**" also on the site. We have been given the honor by Lt. Bobby Ross (composer and artist) to introduce four of his latest songs dedicated to veterans of Iraq and Afghanistan as well as George Jones allowing us to post his tribute song "**50,000 Names On The Wall**".

I will begin building the Military Memorial Page, dedicated to veterans (alive as well as deceased) within the next few days for posting of names on our own wall (memorial page). The posting is simple, **but there will also be a one time posting charge of \$10.00 (Ten dollars US) per person nominated (one name = one donation).**

The page will be entitled "**THANK YOU FOR YOUR SERVICE**"

NOTE: Memorial postings will not be in alphabetical order. Each name posted needs to be recognized for their service. By listing as they arrive this will insure every name on our wall will be seen and known.

REQUIRED FOR POSTING:

1. The full name of the service member
2. Dates of Service
3. If deceased - provide date of death
4. Branch of Service along with military rate or rank (example: Petty Officer 2nd class, Sergeant First Class, Specialist, Airman, Lt, General, Commander, etc.)
5. A brief bio consisting of description of their life in the military and as well as civilian, including their family (wife's name and children) **not to exceed 50 words.**
6. The name and relationship of the person submitting the post. The submitter must

include their mailing address and **telephone number** for purpose of verification of information provided (wife, daughter, son, mother, father, brother, sister, etc - blood relationship is not required).

7. (you may include a small photo of the service member, please do so in .jpeg format)

METHOD OF POSTING AND PAYMENT:

E-Mail your posting information to: publisher@toomuch-bs.com or wbennett@proaxis.com do not use font size larger than 10pt

Payment will be by utilizing your credit card or bank check via secured PayPal link from the website article page. Approximately 3/4's down the article page from the top you will find a black box with several payment buttons. Click the button below the **\$10.00** donation info. You will automatically be taken to the payment section. As part of the payment submission indicate the name of the person being memorialized in addition to your own name. You will receive payment confirmation direct from PayPal, and it will show "eagle feather homes", that is one of my companies and all payments are processed via that particular PayPal account.

Once we have received your posting nomination and payment, the person and their bio will be posted within 48 hours. We will attempt to complete the post the same day as being received.

Be advised, I will call you to verify the information of the service member being memorialized is accurate and correct -- this eliminates the possibility of typo's and incorrect info.
